Bulletin No. 41, page 31: Builder's Numbers of Adelaide, Glenelg and Suburban Railway Engines Nos. 11 and 13 (later South Australian Railway's Nos. 165 and 166 should read 3873 and 3874. These engines were built by Beyer Peacock in 1897.

Bulletin No. 42, April, 1941, page 29: Western Australian Government Railways G class Engines, Nos. 119, 136, 120 and 121, sold to the Commonwealth Railways, were renumbered 39, 40, 41 and 41 respectively. This corrects previous information of the subject.
