Visit to Lindfield Station 17 August 2011 Why would two buildings built on opposite platforms

ARHS Life Member John Oakes spoke of the track layout necessary for the terminating of trains, both steam and electric.

There being no suitable eateries nearby, the group travelled the short distance to Chatswood RSL for lunch.
