- No more than 2 customers in the store at one time, so you may need to wait outside

- 2. Henderson Road Opening we will be opening Henderson Rd Bookshop from 14 July on the following days and hours
 - Tuesday 10.00am to 4.00pm
 - Wednesday 10.00am to 4.00pm
 - Thursday 10.00am to 4.00pm

There will be tight restrictions and requirements in place, so we ask for everyone's patience and cooperation:

- Please use the Hand Sanitiser on the way into the store
- No more than 20 customers in the store at one time, so you may need to wait outside
- Please observe Social Distancing practices at all times
