## The Renumbering of the VR Stephenson A<sup>2</sup> Class

tarting in late 1923, the VR renumbered the A² class locomotives to the number group 800 to 999, with some class members already occupying numbers in this range. The Walschaerts valve gear equipped locomotives were allocated the numbers 940 to 999, and those not already carrying numbers in this group were renumbered in blocks, retaining the last one or two digits of their original number.

The renumbering of the Stephenson valve gear locomotives was more complicated. These were renumbered putting superheated locomotives at the upper end of the number range. This meant that all the high numbered locomotives were superheated, since the Walschaerts equipped locomotives, numbered above the Stephenson locomotives, were all superheated by this time.

This meant that a number of A<sup>2</sup> locomotives with high numbers, already superheated, were not renumbered. Thus, for example, 920, 923 and 924, 928 and 929, 931 and 934 to 937 retained their original numbers throughout their life.

At the other end of the range, locomotives 800 to 803 retained their numbers as locomotives without superheaters until they

were superheated. These then received higher numbers, those being superheated earlier getting higher numbers in the new list.

In some cases, number plates were swapped between high numbered locomotives without superheaters and low numbered locomotives with superheaters, when they were in workshops together.

To clarify which locomotives had superheaters, a new classification of  $A^1$  was introduced for locomotives without superheaters from May 1929. Despite this new class, the numbers of locomotives without superheaters were altered to keep the numbers of locomotives without superheaters below the numbers of those with superheaters (as shown in the table of  $A^1$  Numbers.)

So, in general, the later a locomotive was superheated, the lower its number appeared in the list of superheated locomotives. One exception to this was the second locomotive built, originally 574. When this locomotive was fitted with a superheater in late 1946, the next available number was 820. However, another superheated locomotive, 878, was written off earlier in 1946, and the former 574 took the number 878. The remaining locomotives were numbered in sequence, although there was a time gap before the remaining locomotives were superheated in 1948 and 1949.

But a result of the re use of the number was that only 124 numbers were used in the list of superheated Stephenson A<sup>2</sup>s, one less than the number built.

The numerical tabulation is based on that published as an on line extra to ARH 982 in August 2019 by Milton Biddle. This in turn was based on lists by the late John Buckland and additional data provided by Peter Medlin in his book VR Locomotives by Number. I have added the mid 1920s renumbering dates and the dates of reclassification to  $A^1$ , where available, and the dates of renumbering as class  $A^1$  where available. Most of my additions came from Peter Medlin's book, but some data came from Mark Bau's Victorian Railways website. In particular Mark has scanned the locomotive record cards for the  $A^2$  Class among others, thankfully including both locomotives numbered 878 in the superheated list.

From Mark Bau's record cards, I have corrected the superheating dates of three locomotives shown in John Buckland's original lists. Two of these were converted in the same week, and the cards updated by the same person. The corrected dates are shown in red. **ARH**
