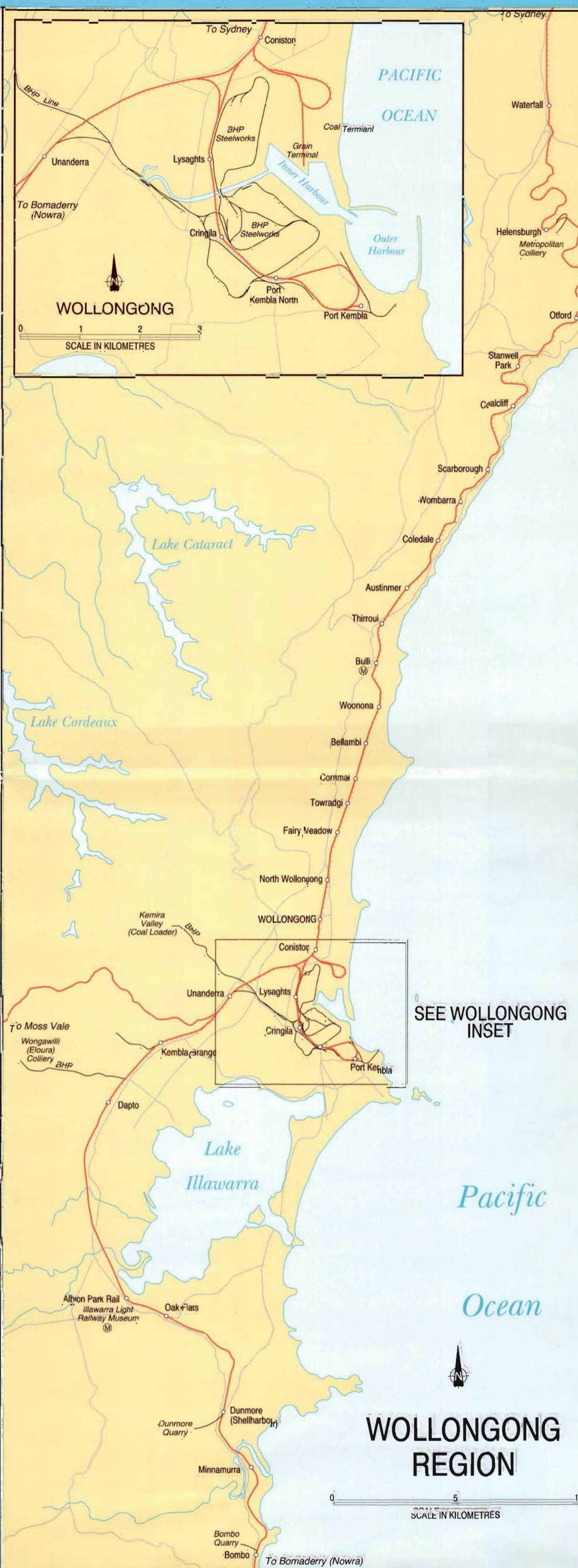


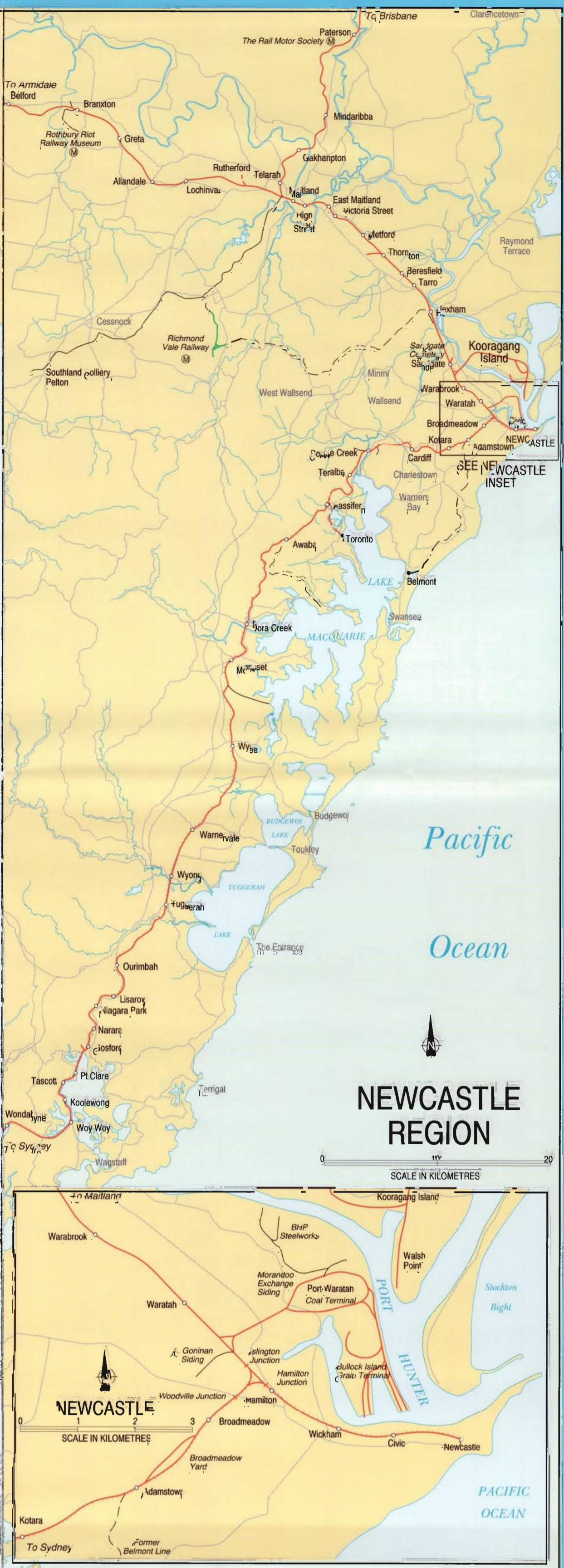
SYDNEY METROPOLITAN

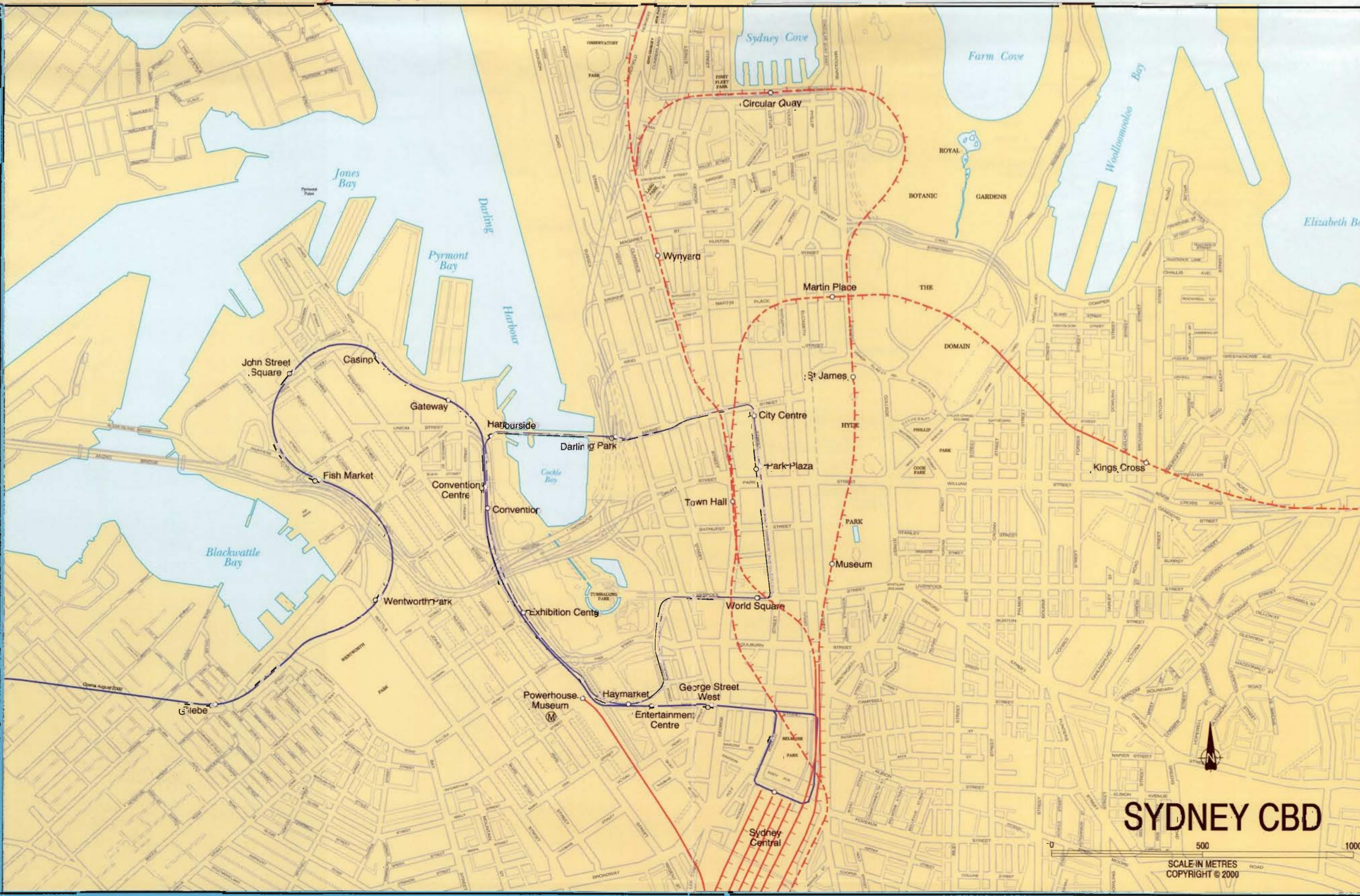

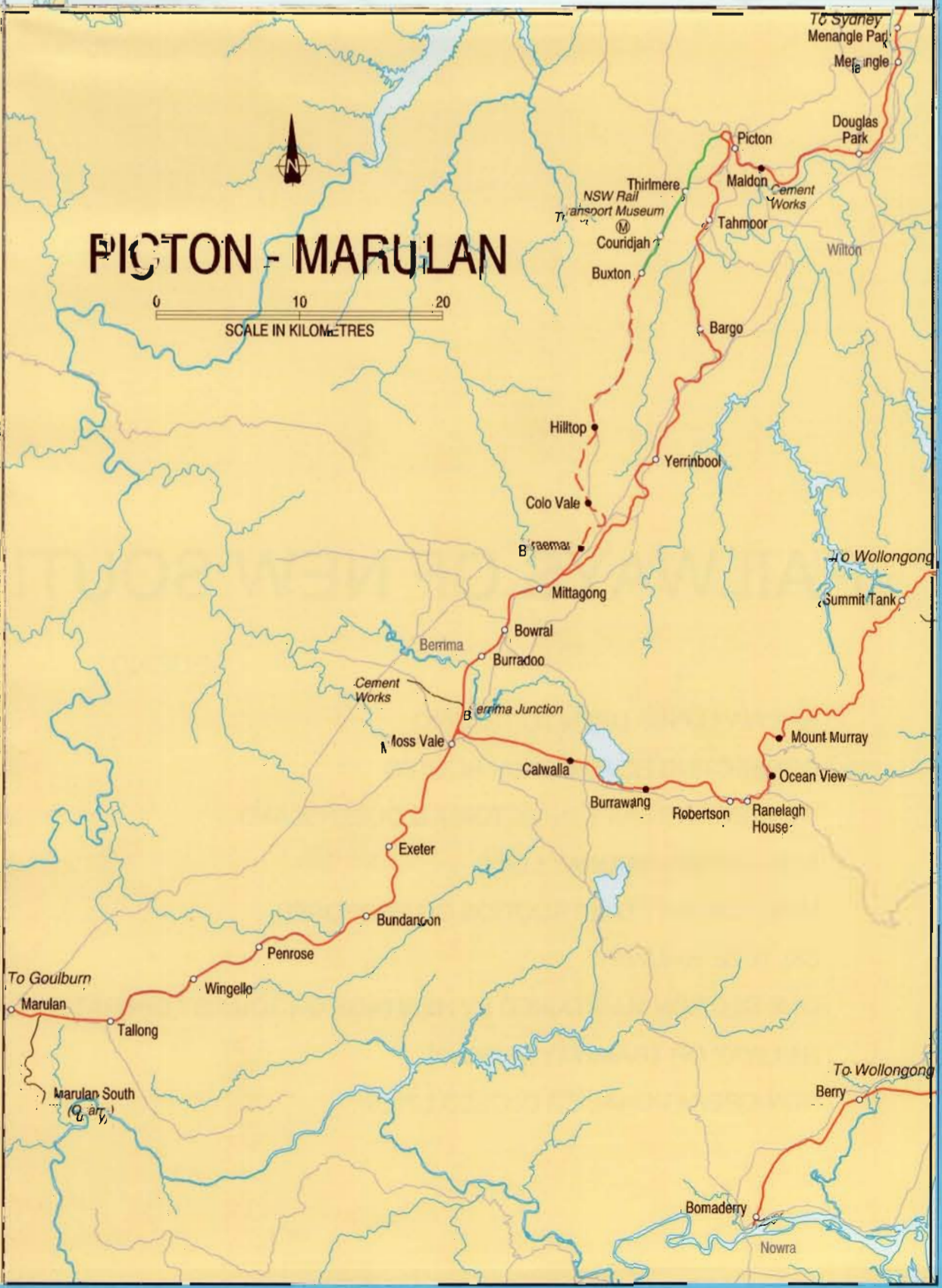
This map shows the New South Wales railway system as at 1st July, 2000. It shows all lines open to passenger and/or freight traffic together with two lines which will be commissioned in the second half of the year (Kandos - Gulgong and Metro Light Rail's extension from Wentworth Park to Catherine Street, Leichhardt). In addition, lines are included that are currently non-operational or closed where substantial remains may be seen. All stations served by CityRail, Countrylink or independent passenger trains are included together with the main connecting coach routes. Electrified lines are identified. Private industrial railways and lines normally used only by heritage groups are colour-coded. The main railway and tramway museums are marked.

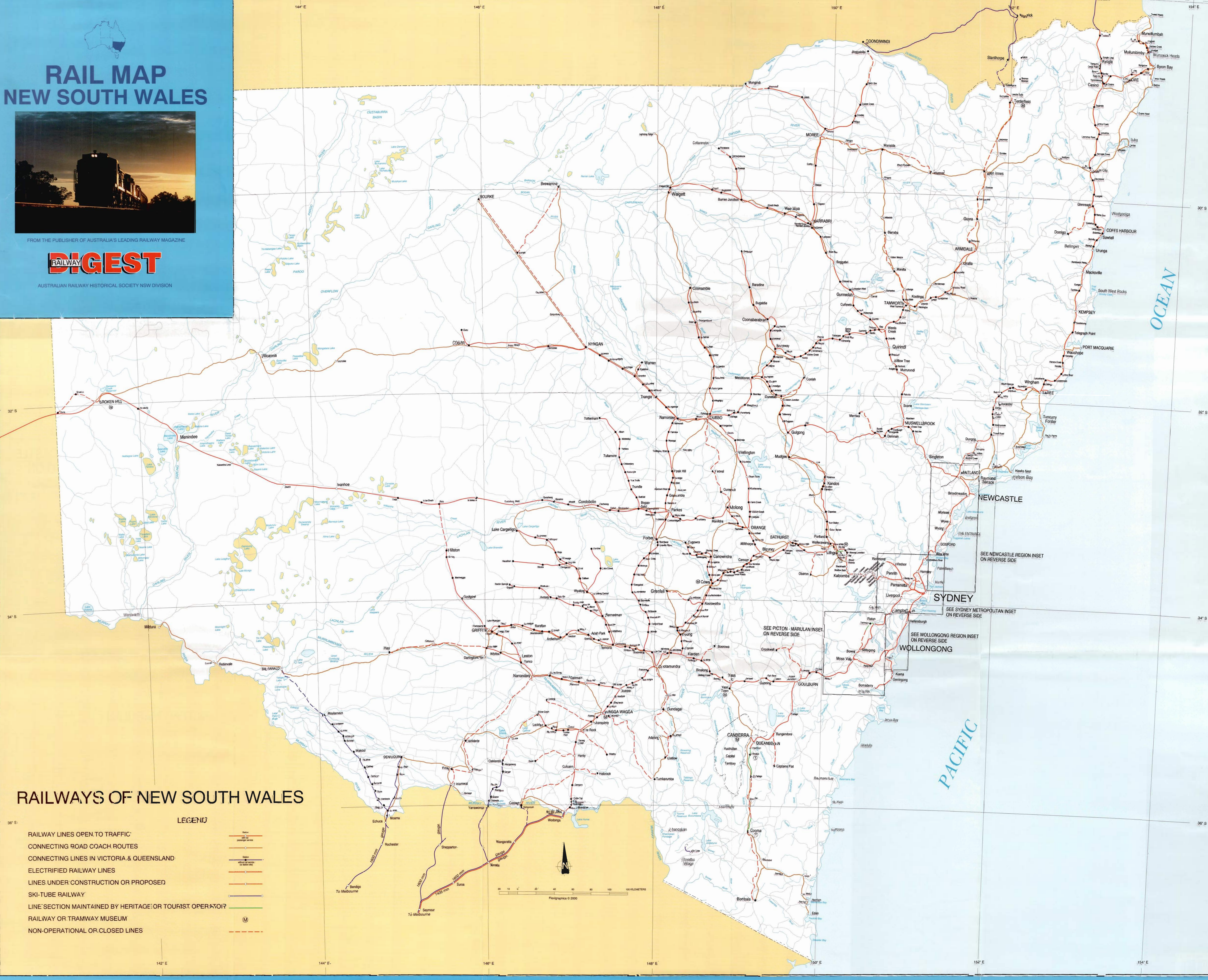
RAIL MAP NEW SOUTH WALES
