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Friday 23 October 2026 visit to Alstom Dandenong to see the building of G Class Trams and XTrapolis II Components & Assembly Area 35-45 Frankston-Dandenong Road Dandenong South

Meet at Town Hall Station at 9:50am on the Platform, look at SRL Work at Clayton from Station Platform prior to Lunch at Clayton RSL.

We meet at Town Hall Station on the Platform, we will be travelling in the second car from the front, travelling on the 10:10am service to Clayton.

After lunch we travel from Clayton Station to Dandenong Station, then 901 Bus to Alstom.

On leaving Alstom we reverse the order 901 to Dandenong Station then train back to Town Hall Station arriving at 5:33pm.

Mandatory PPE:

Ankle-high steel-cap boots (no steel-caps, then closed toe & flat shoes - toe clips can be provided)

Long pants (no skirts, dresses, or shorts)

Shirts or tops with sleeves

Hi-vis vest (pink vests supplied for visitors / non-inducted staff)

Bump cap or hard hat, safety glasses, and hearing protection (required in manufacturing areas – supplied onsite if needed)

Site Rules:

Visitors must always be escorted outside the main reception building.

Mobile phone use is permitted only when stationary and in safe, marked walkways.

No photos or videos without prior approval.

There will be a \$5 fee for Tour Notes & Administration charge.
